All Maintenance works shall be performed in accordance with the procedures laid down in Air Mauritius Line Work Instructions Manual and the applicable Air Mauritius Aircraft Maintenance Manuals and documentation.

The Specific works to be performed consist of the following:

- Preflight, Transit, Weekly checks, (if authorised) defects rectification observed during these inspections or reported by Crew in Technical Log / Cabin Log books.
- Record information, certify, checks and defects rectification in Technical Log/ Cabin Log books in accordance with Air Mauritius Line Work Instructions Manual.
- Issue Certificate of Release to Service (CRS) with reference to **Mauritius DCA MCAR Part 145 Approval Reference MU-145.101** and in accordance with Air Mauritius Line Work Instructions Manual.

This Authorisation Certificate shall remain valid until **28-Nov-2026** or until the contract signed within the scope of the Line Maintenance activity between **Air Mauritius Ltd** and **Storm Aviation Ltd** is terminated, whichever is the sooner, unless previously suspended, varied or revoked by Air Mauritius Compliance Monitoring.

In addition, this Authorisation is subject to a positive result from the periodical Audits/ Surveillance Activity conducted by Air Mauritius Compliance Monitoring and can be revoked at any time, if any of the above conditions are not fulfilled.

**Note:**

Subject to compliance with the foregoing conditions, **Storm Aviation Ltd** shall immediately inform Air Mauritius Compliance Monitoring if its Mauritius Civil Aviation Department Approval or NAA Approval or EASA Part -145 Approval is surrendered, superseded, suspended or revoked.
